I. Introduction

Welcome to KOICONNECT LTD!

This Cookie Policy ("Cookie Notice") is intended to inform you about the use of cookies and other tracking technologies on the website <https://koinsky.com> (the "Website"), which is owned and operated by KOICONNECT LTD (the "Company"). These technologies, as further detailed in our Cookie Notice, are utilized to enhance your browsing experience, improve website functionality, and ensure security while using the Website.

II. What are Cookies?

A cookie is a small file composed of letters and numbers that our Website asks your browser to store on your device. Cookies enable us to gather information regarding your usage of the Website, which allows us to provide statistical insights and offer you an optimal browsing experience. Cookies help the Website to function properly.

Depending on their lifespan, cookies can be either persistent or session cookies:

- **Persistent cookies** remain on your device until their expiry or until you choose to delete them.
- **Session cookies** are deleted immediately once you close your web browser (end the browser session).

III. Types of Cookies We Use

Cookies help us ensure the Website functions properly by providing essential features such as page navigation and access to secure areas. These cookies do not collect any personal data. Without these cookies, our Website will not perform fully, and we may not be able to offer certain core functions and features.

a) Automatically Activated Cookies Upon Visit:

- **Session Cookies:** These are stored in your device memory and are only saved until the browser is closed. They help our Website understand how you navigate from page to page, remembering actions taken on previous pages, and ensuring website security and basic functions. These cookies are not saved to your device's hard disk and do not collect any data from your device.
- **Persistent Cookies:** These cookies are stored on your device's hard disk and remain even when the browser is closed. Persistent cookies help us recognise you as a returning user, allowing us to remember your preferences and actions from prior visits. These cookies are stored for a set period of time, based on the type of cookie.

b) Cookies Activated Upon User Interaction:

- **Essential (Functional) Cookies:** These cookies are necessary for basic website functionality, such as logging in and securely accessing protected areas. They allow the Website to remember your choices and ensure a personalised experience. These cookies do not track your activities on other websites and do not collect personal information.
- **Statistics Cookies:** These cookies collect information about how you use the Website, such as the pages you visit, how fast the pages load, the links you click on, and whether they lead to functioning pages. This data is anonymised and is not used to identify you personally.
- **Analytics Cookies:** These cookies help us understand your actions on the Website and gather your feedback through tools like heatmaps, session recordings, and surveys. This information helps us improve the Website's performance and usability.
- **Marketing Cookies:** These cookies collect information about your browsing habits to create a user profile. They are used to deliver ads tailored to your interests, limit the number of times an ad is shown, assess the effectiveness of advertising campaigns, and understand your behaviour after interacting with ads. We also use third-party cookies for advertising purposes, such as those from Google and other advertisers, to personalise and optimise marketing communications. Third-party advertisers may use cookies to track your interactions and personalise the ads you see based on data such as your geographic location (via your IP address).

IV. Third-Party Cookies

We may allow third-party service providers to place cookies on your device to enhance your experience on our Website. These third parties, such as advertisers, social media platforms, and analytics providers, may collect information about your browsing activities across various websites. The information they gather is used to analyse trends, deliver personalised advertising, and measure the effectiveness of marketing campaigns.

For example, a third-party advertising service might use cookies to track your interaction with ads on our Website and then show you relevant advertisements on other sites based on your interests. Similarly, an analytics service may use cookies to gather data about how you navigate the Website, enabling us to improve the user experience.

While we do not control the cookies set by these third-party services, we want you to be aware that their cookies may track your online activities and help shape the ads you see across the web.
